

Grant Programs 2017



All grant programs will open on **Monday 3 April 2017** at a public launch event, 9:30am at Council Chambers. Meet grant managers and learn about the specific programs and what they will fund. A great opportunity to meet other members in the community and learn from their experiences with grant programs. The funding round will close 5pm **Monday 8 May 2017**.

Council's grant programs include:

Aboriginal Projects Fund

\$35,000 annually
Grants up to \$10,000

Aims to support and empower the local Aboriginal community. Open to the whole community.

Cultural Projects Fund

\$60,000 annually
Grants up to \$3,000

Contribute to a stronger sense of belonging and pride in the community as well as activate local places through development and delivery of cultural initiatives.

Environmental Projects Fund*

a. 355c Committees of Council
Grants up to \$2,000

Environmental projects on land under Council's care and control, including weeding, planting native endemic species and erosion control.

b. Schools can apply for up to \$500 for environmental projects for their schools

*Only open to 355c Committees and schools

Community Projects Fund

\$36,000 annually
Grants up to \$2,000

Aims to support sporting, community service activities and community celebrations.

Heritage Projects Fund

Grants up to \$2,000 to be matched dollar for dollar

Aims to support heritage assessments, conservation policies and management plans as well as conservation work on heritage buildings, heritage landscape works and interpretation projects involving research and presentation of heritage items.
