



Membership

Library membership is free.

Proof of name and current address is required. Membership, including unsupervised access to the internet, must be approved by a parent or guardian when the applicant is under 17 years of age.

Borrowing

Library members may borrow a total of 20 items per visit with a max of 40 items on loan at one time. The following loan periods apply:

Books/Audio Books	4 weeks	Magazines	2 weeks
Popular Items	2 weeks	CDs & DVDs	2 weeks

Items may be renewed once if they have not been requested by another customer. Items that are not returned by their due date will attract an overdue fee. No overdue fees are charged for items borrowed by children on their own library card.
