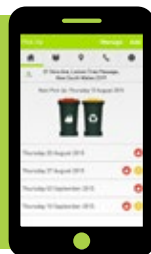
The items listed on this page are not accepted in either of your kerbside bins. But there are other ways to dispose of them for free.

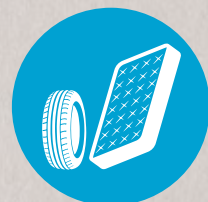


Kerbside collection
