REQUEST FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

RECOMMENDATION IS THAT COUNCIL:

1) Approves provision of financial assistance under Section 356 of the Local Government Act 1993 from Mayoral and Ward funds to the following:-

- a) The Parent Teacher Fellowship at St Phillips Christian School Mayoral funds \$2000 donation towards fireworks display for the St Phillips Fair.
- b) Trek4Kidz Mayoral funds \$500 donation towards rally car sponsorship for the Trek4Kidz event to raise funds for the Starlight Children's Foundation.
- c) Nelson Bay Diggers Bowls Club Mayoral funds \$1000 donation towards transportation costs for travelling bowlers.
- d) Northern Hawks Rugby League Club Mayoral funds \$2805 donation towards Indigenous jerseys for NAIDOC Week.
- e) Rotary Club of Raymond Terrace Mayoral funds \$710 donation towards storage fees for a third shipping container for the furniture bank.
- f) Nelson Bay Tennis Club Mayoral funds \$1000 donation towards costs associated with holding the Seniors Tennis Tournament.
- g) Rivergum Kinship Carers Ward funds East & West Ward \$1500 donation towards Carers & Kids Christmas Party at Port Stephens Koala Sanctuary.
