

Make a positive change

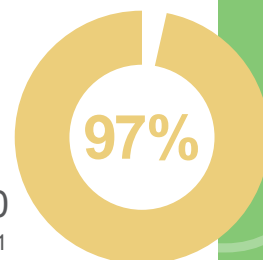
