

Port Stephens Council is planning to undertake improvements to George Reserve, Salamander Bay

Project background

Staged improvements at George Reserve will be undertaken in 2020.

Stage 1 will include new park furniture. These improvements have been funded through successful grant application by the Rotary Club of Salamander Bay from the NSW Government's Community Building Partnership program.

Stage 2 will include replacing the existing amenities building with a new amenities building. The funding for this project has been endorsed through Council in August 2019 as part of the Port Stephens 2020 works program.

Project details and timing

Stage 1 — Early February 2020

New park furniture includes:

- An 8m x 4m skillion picnic shelter designed for coastal conditions (shown below);
- 3 picnic settings; and
- 2 park seats

Please see the map overleaf which details the specific location of the new park furniture. These works are expected to begin in early February 2020 and should take two weeks to complete.

Stage 2 — mid 2020

New amenities building

The works associated with replacing the new amenities building are planned to occur during mid 2020.

The new amenities building will provide accessible facilities and beach shower. The details of the amenities are still being finalised and may vary from the image below.

The existing facilities will not be operational during construction.
