

We're planning the building of a new canteen and amenities for Stuart Park, Hinton

Project background

In August 2019 we allocated \$1.2M of additional funding to upgrade Stuart Park in Hinton.

These funds will go towards the construction of 2 new buildings to replace the existing amenities and temporary canteen. The new buildings are to be located in similar positions to the existing buildings.

The new buildings have been designed with 'best practice' in heritage management to respect the historic grandstand. The design of the new buildings provide a contrast to the heritage features of the grandstand and trees in Stuart Park and will ensure there is no confusion about the heritage aspect and contemporary construction.

Project details

The new amenities building will include:

- Change rooms;
- Unisex bathrooms;
- Accessible and public toilets;
- Referees rooms; and a
- First aid room.

The canteen will be a stand-alone building.
