Boyd Oval | October 2020



Port Stephens Council is planning to construct a new amenities building at Boyd Oval, Medowie.

Project background

We've allocated \$1.4M from developer contributions to upgrade Boyd Oval at Medowie.

The funds will go towards constructing a new purpose built amenities building to replace the existing facilities.

The new building will be constructed near the existing location, but will be shifted slightly to a more central location improving the connection to both playing fields, widening the viewing corridor and provide an improved spectator experience.

Port Stephens Council has had discussions with the current primary users of the area including the Rugby Union Club to ensure the new facility meets the needs of the users.

Project details

The new building will feature:

- Change rooms;
- Canteen;
- Unisex bathrooms;
- Accessible and standard toilets;
- · Referees rooms; and a
- First aid room.

The colours and materials of the new building are still to be finalised.

Timing

Construction is planned to begin in April 2021 and should take 6 months to complete.
