

**Shoal Bay foreshore upgrade
Important information
Regarding upcoming works**

Dear resident/business operator

The Shoal Bay foreshore revitalisation works are underway with the new amenities now complete. The next stage of works includes a new shared pathway, landscaping and park furniture.

These major works are expected to begin in mid-May 2021 and are scheduled for completion by the end of August 2021.

The overall concept plan for these works can be found over the page or detailed plans are available on our website.

The works will be carried out by a specialised sub-contractor and have been scheduled to occur during the less busy time of the year.

However, we understand these works are likely to impact on nearby residents and businesses and are working with our sub-contractor to minimise these impacts as much as possible.

Throughout the project access to the existing footpath closest to the beach may be closed to ensure public safety. Pedestrians are encouraged to follow detour signs and fencing to access the beach safely, which will change as the works progress.

There will also be some noise from the construction and our hours of work are from 7am to 4pm Monday to Friday, 7am to 2:30pm Saturdays. However, at this stage we are not planning to undertake works on the weekend to avoid excessive impacts.

For the duration of the work there will be an unavoidable loss of parking in varying areas along the length of the foreshore. We encourage you to advise customers and staff to park at the off street parking on the corner of Government and Shoal Bay Road.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation whilst we complete these works.
