

Tilligerry projects

A community drop in session will be held on Wednesday, 9 December to present plans covering a range of projects in Tilligerry. These projects include:

- New location for Tilligerry skatepark at Kooindah Reserve, Lemon Tree Passage
- Shared paths between Mallabula and Lemon Tree Passage along Lemon Tree Passage Road and Kawarren Street
- Shared paths around Tanilba Bay town centre along sections of various streets
- Beautification concepts for the Avenue of the Allies roundabout
- New location for the replacement playground at Mallabula Sports Complex
- Location for the new tennis court at Mallabula Sports Complex
- Location of new shared paths through the Mallabula sports complex
- More detail regarding the soccer/athletics amenities building upgrade


