ON BECOMING AWARE OF AN EMERGENCY

REMOVE PEOPLE FROM DANGER AREA.

Assist others (particularly those that may be mobility impaired) to the facility's Emergency Assembly Area as shown below.

ALERT OCCUPANTS & RAISE THE ALARM.

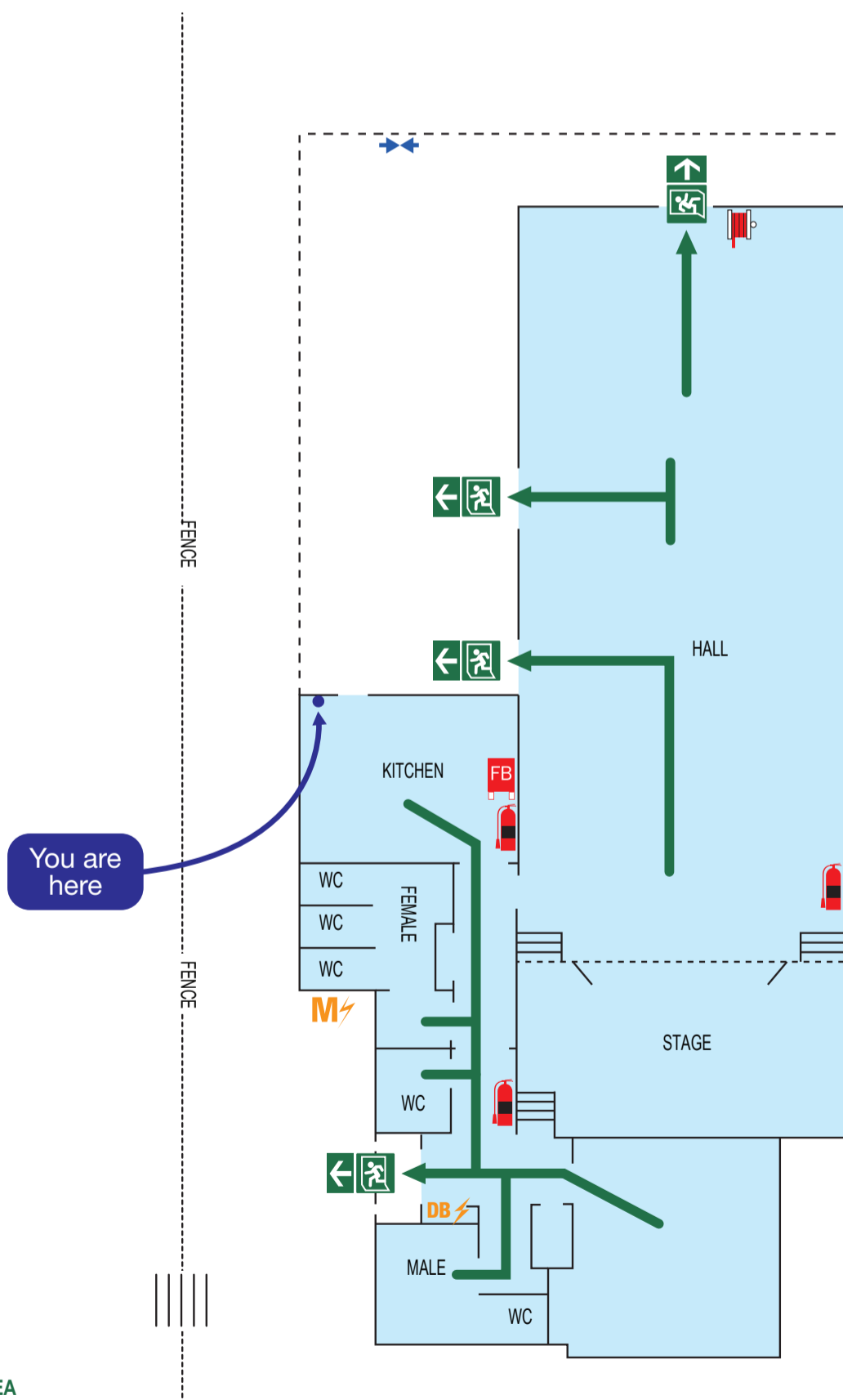
Ensure the Fire Brigade is notified -Dial 000. Activate any facility Emergency Warning Systems where installed (for example manual call point on the front of the fire indicator panels). Contact PSC representative and tell them what has occurred when it is safe to do so.

EVACUATE TO A SAFE AREA.

Evacuate the building via the nearest safe exit route and wait for assistance from responding emergency services. Do not re-enter the facility unless instructed it is safe to do so (by the emergency service personnel).

CONFINE THE SMOKE & FIRE.

Restrict the spread of the fire. Attempt to extinguish the fire, **only if safe and trained to do so**. Work in pairs.
