What is a parklet?

- A footpath extension creating more space for people
- Converts parking spaces into new community spaces
- A mix of seating, tables, planting and art
- Creates more space for outdoor dining for nearby cafes and restaurants

Benefits

- encourages people to slow down and spend more money with local business
- influences drivers to slow down – making streets safer for people
- creates more space for business activity
- new public space to sit and relax
- temporary – they give us a chance to trial what works.

Shoal Bay Proposal

- 3 new parklet areas (across 5 car spaces)*
- opportunity for local performance and activities in the spaces
- showcasing local artist work
- planning to install in March 2021

*** We have offset any loss of parking spaces from this proposal with the creation of new temporary car spaces in the Shoal Bay CBD area.**

Parklets will be located between Zenith Cafe and Giannis.
