Boat ramp upgrade | March 2021

Port Stephens Council is planning to upgrade the boat ramp and amenities at Little Beach.

Project background

Port Stephens Council has been successful in an application for a \$1.67 million Boating Now grant from the NSW Government. The funding will be used to upgrade the boat ramp and public amenities at Little Beach as well as improve pedestrian and vehicle access in the area.

Project details

The new boat ramp will be designed to ensure a better boating experience for users.

The new boat ramp will be higher and longer than the existing boat ramp. It will be built on piles or piers which will allow for natural sand movement under the ramp. This is designed to prevent sand inundation on the boat ramp structure.

The new boat ramp will also have a more gradual slope than the existing boat ramp which will help provide safer boat handling movements including reversing and off loading.
