Clarence Town Road | April 2021

Port Stephens Council is currently undertaking a major upgrade of a section of Clarence Town Road.

Project background

Thanks to funding from the Australian Federal Government 'Roads of Strategic Importance' fund we're upgrading a 900m section of Clarence Town Road.

The road between Carmichael's Corner Seaham and Timbertop Road Glen Oak - known locally as the 'riverflat' section - will be upgraded building on the major reconstruction works carried out on Carmichael's Corner in 2014.

Project details

The scope of works is shown over the page and involves road realignment, increasing the road width, removing hazards from the roadside and improving the condition of the road pavement.

The realignment of the road will help to ensure that road safety is improved by reducing the severity of the road bend.

Environmental mitigation measures are in place during construction to prevent damage to important riverbank vegetation and the river itself.

Timeframe

Works began in January 2021 under single lane closure and stop/slow traffic control conditions.

There will continue to be some traffic delays to motorists until the works are complete.

Works are expected to be complete in May 2021, weather permitting.
