

Birubi Point Aboriginal Place Tourism Transport Interchange

The development of a new visitor interchange was identified as part of the Birubi Point Aboriginal Place Management Plan. As part of the initial works, we've managed the removal of a large amount of sand from the site to allow us to begin the main building works. Rather than moving the sand off-site, we've been working with neighbouring landowners including the Worimi Local Aboriginal Land Council to investigate options of retaining the sand onsite.

Working through this sand management process has impacted our project delivery schedule.

- **Lemon Tree Passage Roadworks** The planning and design works are underway for Lemon Tree Passage Road (near Oyster Cove). The road safety improvements are scheduled to start in August 2023.

Anna Bay Smart Parking

Investigations and community engagement for the expansion of Smart Parking to other areas in Port Stephens will begin soon. We're looking at the Birubi Headland parking area including the bottom car park and Robinson Reserve carpark. Additionally, the One Mile Beach parking area will be improved and upgraded from a gravel to a sealed car park after summer 2023/2024. We value your input and will be seeking your opinions on the roll-out process, including any potential timing restrictions and suggestions for the allocation of funds raised from Smart Parking.

Anna Bay Place Plan

The engagement and development of the Anna Bay Place Plan is currently on hold while we prepare some additional development studies, which are expected to be finalised in the next 12 months. Once developed and endorsed, the Anna Bay Place Plan will replace the Anna Bay Strategy and Town Plan. We'll continue to have conversations with our community about the development studies and once completed, will revisit the Anna Bay Place Plan.

The new town works in Lemon Tree Passage have started! Located next to the Henderson Park Playground, you'll see changes as the construction is underway, which will include a 290m² paved open space as well as outdoor seating, planting and lighting. The new space will be used as a community event and meeting space.
