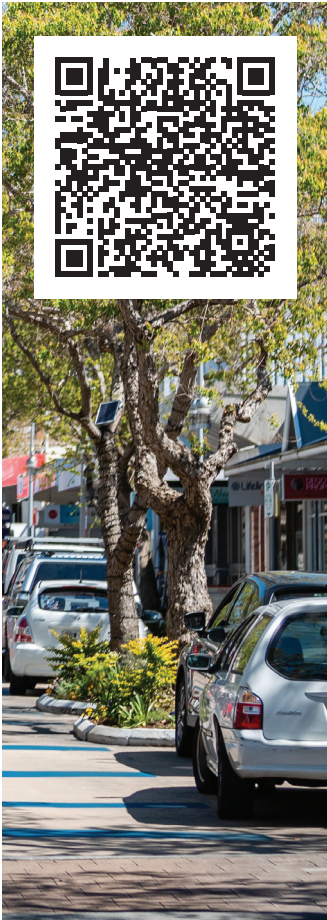


Smart Parking

Smart Parking has been approved to be extended to Little Beach and Fingal Bay following the Council's decision on 12 March 2024.

Community feedback collected in late 2023 has influenced how the set-up of Smart Parking at Fingal Bay will work. This feedback has meant that there will be new parking regulations and directional signage to address community concerns regarding impacts on neighbouring streets. This feedback also included requests for longer time limits and as a result the area near Barry Park will be 9 hours to allow for longer stays. The remaining area at the surf club and along the beach foreshore will be 4 hours. A map of the extent at Fingal Bay is shown over the page. For permit holders please remember that you still need to follow the time restrictions at the location where you have parked.

The introduction of Smart Parking at Fingal Bay is projected to raise \$120,000 annually. These funds will be placed in a dedicated reserve, Fingal Bay Precinct Smart Parking Reserve, and will go towards the endorsed Infrastructure Program. The meters and signs are now being installed at Fingal Bay and are expected to be operational from 13 May 2024.



Fingal project updates

The new shared path works at Marine Drive are almost complete with only minor works now outstanding.

Barry Park car park area 9P = 9 hours

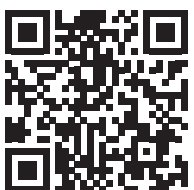
Foreshore parking area 4P = 4 hours
