



## **Smart Parking**

Smart Parking has been approved to be extended to Little Beach, Fingal Bay and Birubi Headland following the Council's decision on 12 March 2024.

Community feedback collected in late 2023 has influenced how the set-up of Smart Parking at Little Beach will work. This feedback has meant that there will be new parking regulations and directional signage to address community concerns regarding impacts on neighbouring streets. This feedback also included requests for longer time limits and as a result the Ngioka car park area will be 9 hours to allow for longer stays. The remaining area along the beach foreshore will be 4 hours. The boat ramp area is outside of the Smart Parking extents and time limits do not apply. A map of the extent at Little Beach is shown over the page.

The introduction of Smart Parking at Little Beach is projected to raise \$71,000 annually. These funds will be placed in a dedicated reserve, Nelson Bay Precinct Smart Parking Reserve and will go towards the endorsed Infrastructure Program. The meters have now been installed at Little Beach and are expected to be operational from 15 April 2024.
