I refer to your letter regarding the declaration of the Hunter Offshore Wind Zone and the motions carried by Port Stephens Council on the 10th & 24th of October.

As Councillors are aware, the declaration of the Hunter Offshore Wind Zone was made by the Commonwealth Government. The approval process for any future proposals, are also the responsibility of the Commonwealth Government.

As Councillors are also aware, to date, there has not been any windfarm proposal submitted, considered or approved.

Since the declaration of the Hunter Offshore Wind Zone by the Federal Government, I have spoken with local recreational and commercial fishers, local tourism operators and residents regarding their concerns.

Many residents have also shared their concerns with me via letters, emails and social media.

I have raised all of the concerns that have been shared with me, with The Hon Chris Bowen MP, Federal Minister for Climate Change & Energy, The Hon Tanya Plibersek MP, Federal Minister for the Environment & Water and The Hon Penny Sharpe MLC, Minister for Climate Change, Minister for Energy, Minister for Heritage and Minister for the Environment in NSW.
