## Ferodale Road, Medowie - Request for disabled parking at Medowie Public School

Requested by: A resident

#### Background:

At the February Local Traffic Committee meeting, Committee members recommended installation of an accessible parking space at Medowie Public School. Staff from the Department of Education and Training have since contacted Council to request that the proposed accessible parking space has time restrictions installed, to prevent possible abuse of the space. The requested intent of the space is for a setdown / pick-up space with accessibility and the concern is that without time restrictions, the space could be occupied all day by a mobility permit holder.

The Asset Services Officer has requested the following:

"Our requirement is for a dedicated drop-off space, rather than a standard disabled parking space. The intention is to provide a designated area – ideally in the area already earmarked - where assisted travel students can be safely dropped off and access the school, similar to a Kiss and Ride but specifically for disabled students. Would it be possible to signpost this as a disable Kiss and Ride? This would ensure that the space is available for continuous drop-offs, rather than being occupied by a parked vehicle, which could prevent other students who need it, from using it."

#### **Discussion:**

TfNSW representatives advised that accessible parking facilities can be time restricted, but that there would need to be good communication with the school community to ensure that people are aware of the restrictions.

Cr Niland advised that he had spoken with the original applicant who indicated that a 10 minute time restriction would address the concerns regarding the possibility of someone parking in the space all day.

#### **Committee's recommendation:**

Add a 10 minute time limit to the previously approved accessible parking restrictions at Medowie Public School. The 10 minute restrictions are to apply only during the school zone operational times, on school days.

## Brocklesby Road, Medowie - Review of proposed regulatory signage

**Background:** 

This request relates to a development application for recently rezoned land at Medowie, located just east of the Gardens Estate, connecting to Brocklesby Road.

The northern kerb of the proposed northern road is required to be a no stopping/no parking area for bushfire purposes (in red below). Regulatory signage is proposed (No Stopping sign) or a C3 yellow line on the asphalt.

Speed humps are also proposed adjacent to a proposed widlife corridor.
