Background:

Council is about to start re-construction work on Tuna Crescent, Fingal Bay. The work will involve pavement widening as well as installation of kerb and gutter. The widened pavement will be 8m wide between kerbs. This will restrict parking to one side of the road to ensure that the existing bus services are not impacted.

Proposal to the Forum:

Install 'No Stopping' restrictions as shown on the attached sketch, Annexure A.
